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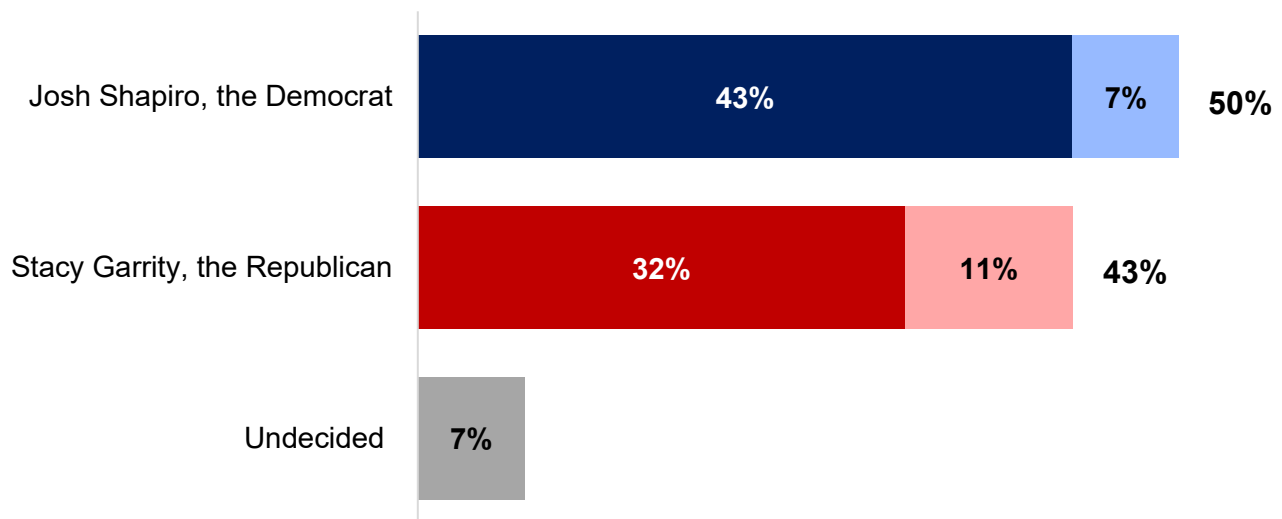

Research Scope & Methodology

NPA Polling recently completed a survey of 600 likely 2026 general election voters in Pennsylvania via live phone (cell and landline) and text-to-web interviews. The sample was drawn from a voter file-based universe and weighted to match the expected general election electorate on key demographics. The margin of error is +/- 4% with a 95% confidence level. Interviews were conducted July 26th – 30th, 2026. Percentages may not equal 100% due to rounding.

Question Text: *If the November 2026 general election for Governor of Pennsylvania were held today, and the candidates were Josh Shapiro, the Democrat, and Stacy Garrity, the Republican, for whom would you vote? Are you definitely or just probably voting for (CANDIDATE CHOSEN)?*
